



Uniform Appearance And Policy 2025/26

At Multinational School Dhahran, our uniforms are designed to promote comfort, practicality, and a strong sense of school identity. Each stage of schooling has a clearly defined dress code to ensure students are dressed appropriately for learning and activities.

Early Years 1, 2 & 3

- Girls: Navy Blue Polo Dress
- Boys: Navy Blue Polo Shirt with school shorts/trousers

Year 2 - 3

- Girls : White Collar/Blue Checks Dress
- Boys : Blue Checks Shirt

Year 4 - 9

- Girls: Light Blue Shirt, Dark Blue Skirt or Trousers
- Boys: Light Blue Shirt, Dark Blue Shorts or Trousers

Physical Education (All Year Groups)

- PE T-Shirts
- PE Pants
- PE Jackets
- PE Shorts

Winter Wear

- Cardigans

General School Uniform

- Only official MNS shirts and navy-blue pants, skirts, shorts, jackets, and hats may be worn.
- Only black or navy leggings may be worn under skirts/shorts.
- If an undershirt is worn, it must be plain white.

Hats & Head Coverings

- Hats or head coverings are not permitted indoors unless for approved medical or religious reasons.
- Religious head coverings must be white, navy blue, or black.

Footwear

- Students must wear plain black shoes, sneakers, or sandals with black laces.
- No boots or high heels are permitted.
- Socks must be plain navy, black, or white.

General Appearance & Hygiene

- Uniforms must be clean, neat, and well-maintained.
- Hair must be tidy, tied back if long, and of a natural colour. Extreme patterns or spiky styles are not permitted.
- Hair accessories must be plain navy, black, or white. Bandanas are not allowed.
- Students are expected to maintain good personal hygiene

Jewellery Makeup

- No necklaces, bracelets, anklets, or rings are permitted.
- Only one small stud earring per ear and a standard watch are allowed.
- Only clear lip balm may be worn. Eye makeup, lipstick, nail varnish or coloured products are not allowed.

Physical Education (PE) Uniform

Students must wear the official MNS PE t-shirt and shorts.
During colder months, the MNS tracksuit pants may be worn.
Sports shoes with non-marking soles are required.
Students must wear school socks or plain white sports socks.

Non-Uniform Days

Clothing must be modest and respectful.
Clothing with inappropriate images, discriminatory messages, or references to tobacco, alcohol, or drugs is strictly prohibited.

Consequences for Non-Compliance

Students will be required to change into appropriate clothing.
If this is not possible, parents will be contacted to bring correct attire.
Repeated violations will lead to warnings and possible suspension until compliance is achieved.
